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## 1-Day Guild Opportunity

*Maximum 24 students*

*Each student will create a unique 11" x 14" collage from one of 3 **pre-selected** photographs in this 1-day introduction workshop.*

*The photo and pattern will be provided.*

*Students will leave class with a solid foundation and all the information needed to finish projects at home.*

*Sewing machines are not needed.*

## 2-Day Guild Opportunity

*Maximum 24 students*

*Each student will create a unique 11" x 14" collage from one of 3 **pre-selected** photographs.*

*The photo and pattern will be provided.*

*2-days allows for an overview of pattern making and creating eyes.*

*Students will leave class with a solid foundation and all the information needed to finish projects at home.*

*Sewing machines are not needed.*

**Join me** for a hands-on, creativity-filled experience where participants will learn every step of the collage process, including:

- Tips for choosing the perfect photo to work with.
- How special effects can help you “see” images with more creativity.
- Step-by-step instructions for designing precise, photorealistic patterns.
- Why **value** is more important than color when selecting fabrics and how **contrast** captures attention and brings your work to life.
- Why my “go-to” fusible is a game-changer.
- How to create backgrounds that will enhance your subject.
- Free-motion quilting techniques that add depth and dimension.
- Creative finishing ideas that go beyond batting & backing.
- And of course... those eyes—everyone’s favorite WOW moment!

Each student will need a minimum of 4' of table space, plus access to outlets for a light pad, a portable iron, and possibly a sewing machine.

There is a **\$50 materials fee per student** for additional supplies I'll provide—items not typically found at your local quilt shop—payable to me on the first day of class.

Please send the registrants’ email addresses to me 60-days prior to the class.

To make the most of our time together, I will reach out to each student individually beforehand, sharing information to help them prepare, including a detailed supply list and an overview of the materials we'll be using. At that time, students will also begin submitting their photos for **pre-approval** and may contact me with any questions they have.

***This workshop is suitable for anyone who loves fabric—including non-quilters.***

## Instructor Fees & Expenses:

- Daily Rate: \$800 per day for 7 hours of hands-on instruction.
- Lecture/Trunk Show: May be added to an existing event for \$250. Typically runs 1½ hours including Q&A. Attendance is based on the venue.

## Lodging:

- If the venue is more than one hour from my home, hotel accommodations –with a favorable traveler-ranking on *Tripadvisor*– are required beginning the night before the event.
- For workshops located more than 2½ hours away, lodging will also be required the last day of class.

**Mileage** will be billed at the current IRS rate.

## Airfare:

- I prefer to drive if the venue is within 7–8 hours of my home. If air travel is necessary, I prefer United, flying non-stop out of CAK or CLE.
- Reimbursement for a fully refundable ticket, two checked bags, seat selection, and ground transportation is required prior to the last day of class.

## Deposit:

- A \$200 deposit is required at the time of booking.
- Cancellations: Generally, either party may cancel with 30 days’ advance notice without penalty. (*See Contract for full details.*)

### 3-Day Workshop

Maximum 18 students

Each student will choose from one of 3 -16" x 20" **pre-selected** photos.

A photo and pattern will be provided.

3-days allows for more in-depth instruction in all areas of the collage process.

Students will leave class with all the information needed to finish projects at home. Sewing machines are not needed.

### 5-Day Workshop

12 students preferred  
18 maximum

Each student will create a 16" x 20" collage using their own **pre-approved** photograph.

We'll have plenty of time for individual attention, including 1-on-1 instruction on creating eyes.

If the venue is equipped, I'll include a

PowerPoint presentation: **"Threads of Influence: Artists I Admire and Lessons I've Learned"**

Most students begin quilting at home. On simpler projects, students may wish to bring a sewing machine and a variety of threads.

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
