



6 Mixx Location Basic Supply List

Enlarged Color Photo:

- **16" X 20", 20" x 24", or 24" x 30" (rectangular) or 16" x 16" or 20" x 20" (square).**
- **Crop the image to remove excess or distracting background.**

A strong reference photo includes sharp focus, a strong center of interest, and good contrast. Animals, flowers from your garden, and landscapes are all excellent choices—whether photographed yourself or selected from another source and used with permission.

Pet portraits—especially those captured mid-bark or with a tongue sticking out—are among the most popular subjects.

When creating a pattern... it's always better to work off your original photo. If you'll have your Ipad or Laptop with you in class, you can pull up any filtered images for reference.

Scissors:

Sharp Embroidery Scissors for cutting fine details and a pair of scissors to cut paper.

Fabric:

A variety of fabrics (cotton, batiks, hand-dyed) ranging in value from light to dark that coordinate with your photo. Scraps that most quilters throw away work great. Nothing larger than ⅓ or ¼ yard is needed. I rarely use solids. I love polka dots, plaids and fabric with text.

Light Pad: As small as 9" by 13" will work great.

Small Travel Iron & Ironing Pad with extension cord.

Sewing Machine and Thread:

Most students quilt their project at home. If your project is simple and you think you'll be ready... bring your machine and a variety of threads.

Additional Fees:

For projects 16" x 20" — supply items not typically found at your local quilt shop are included.

***For larger projects, 20" x 24" or 24" x 30" the materials fee is \$18.00** —payable to me on the first day of class (cash/ck/venmo) One "EYEconic" kit is provided for each breakout session you attend (a \$15 value each). Additional kits will be available for purchase.

I'll reach out to you **60-days prior to the workshop** and provide detailed information on the topics we'll cover in class to help you prepare for our time together, including a comprehensive supply list. At this time you may submit up to 3-4 photos for pre-approval.
